Mont Saint-Sauveur Water Park opens during Summer Festival



First summer season for the new Viking Alpine Coaster, plus two new water slides!

This Saturday, June 5th, the Mont Saint-Sauveur Water Park will open to coincide with the Saint-Sauveur Valley Summer Festival (if weather permits, otherwise the opening will be postponed to Monday June 7th). Although the park's official opening will take place later in the season, many activities will be offered as part of the festivities.

Water lovers will have a number of activities to choose from, including the spa pool and wave pool, as well as the Rivière Rouge, the Rivière du Nord and the Spirales. Everything is set to kick off the official period of rest, relaxation and revitalization at the greatest water park in a mountain setting.

New Viking Alpine Coaster open to the public

Also opening this weekend is our new Alpine Coaster. A big hit last winter, the Viking is back at full speed for the summer. This new four-season activity, which is unique in Canada, represents a \$2.5 million investment for Mont Saint-Sauveur International.

The Torrents: two new water slides opening mid-July

Currently under construction, the Torrents are being built with great care to respect the mountain's natural environment, as always. This represents a \$500,000 investment for the Mont Saint-Sauveur Water Park. Starting mid-July, come brave these two new water slides, which will sweep you away at dizzying speeds!

Acro-Nature and Morin Heights Camping & Cabins are already open!

Morin Heights Camping & Cabins has already been open for the season since early May. Located just outside the Laurentian village of Morin-Heights, this campground is the ideal place to spend relaxing and invigorating vacations with family or friends. The campground features 69 campsites with services (electricity and water), 40 wild campsites with water source and 20 fully equipped log cabins available year-round.

Be sure to come explore the Acro-Nature forest adventure course in Morin-Heights. Make your way along mobile beams, accordion footbridges, timber ladders and zip-lines, including one that is over 987 feet (300.84 metres) long! Acro-Nature consists of four circuits featuring a total of 58 stations and two junior circuits featuring a total of 15 stations.

Starting June 5th, the water park will be open every day, weather permitting, until Labour Day, September 6, 2010. We look forward to welcoming you in our setting that is more beautiful and enchanting than ever, thanks to all the work that our team has done on the site.
